



THE HELP RESOURCES

The HELP website has been completely renewed and it is now open to all interested users. A wide range of European Convention on Human Rights (ECHR) training resources is available on-line, translated into the national languages of the beneficiary countries: training manuals on ECHR Methodology and Key Concepts, Handbooks, standard curricula, course outlines, hundreds of presentations, case studies, e-learning courses on the different articles and themes of the ECHR. It is possible to search by article of the ECHR, or by theme.

Training legal professionals means training highly educated adults. The manual on training methodology provides theoretical information on the principles of educating/training adults and more practical information about how to apply the theory and how to organise a training event.

The website is also used as a platform for distance learning courses and hosts forums to stimulate discussions and debates on Human Rights issues among legal professionals.

The HELP methodologies and resources are systematically used even in the CoE Training-for-Trainers courses on ECHR, organised in the beneficiary countries, frequently in synergy with other CoE projects.
